AGENDA ITEM NO. 1: Call to Order and consider absence requests.

Ms. Garza stated that the Parks Department confirmed Central Park was available on May 21st including the pavilion and restrooms. A portion of Wolf Pen Creek will not be available due to another event happening that day.

There was general discussion amongst the Board members regarding different bike routes submitted. Some of the comments included the following:

- The traffic light stops will be hard to cross for families with small children.

- Routes with hills and rough roads should be reconsidered for participants pulling child carriers.

Board member Langlotz will modify her suggested bike route and will send it out to the Board on or before the March meeting. The Board also agreed to decide on a final route by next month's meeting.
